BRIEF SUMMARY OF BROOK PARK CODES

Romex prohibited in commercial and industrial building.
Romex in garages or outbuildings in residential property must be covered or concealed.
Exposed romex in basements run at right angles to floor joists, must be run with six inches (6") of outside or bearing walls and joists must be drilled.
All branch circuit wiring must be #12 or larger.
Kitchen circuits must have no more than two receptacles per circuit.
Aluminum wire under 100 amps capacity is prohibited.
Service wiring must be installed in metal conduit.
All ceiling boxes must have a fan approved box.
