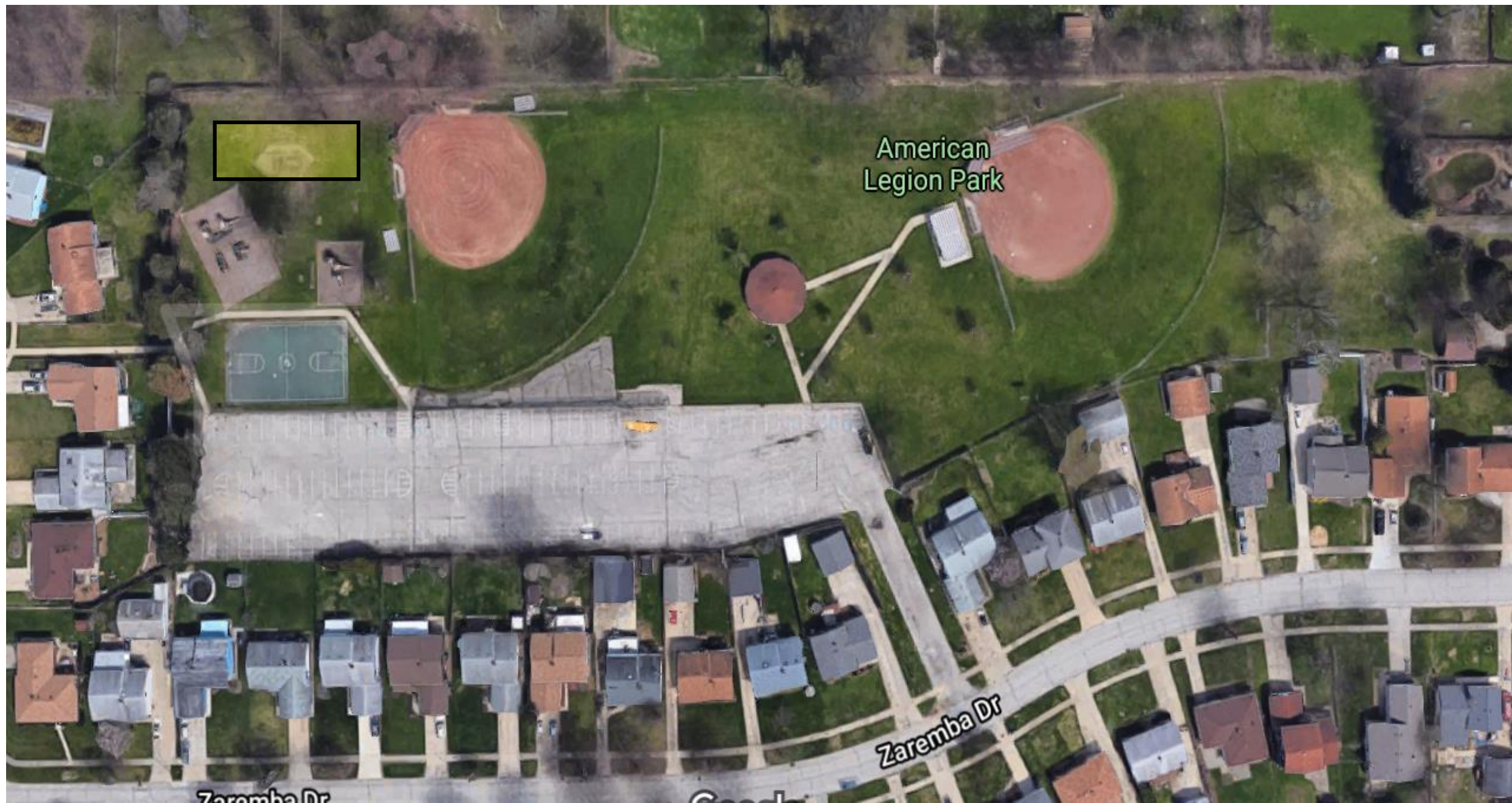

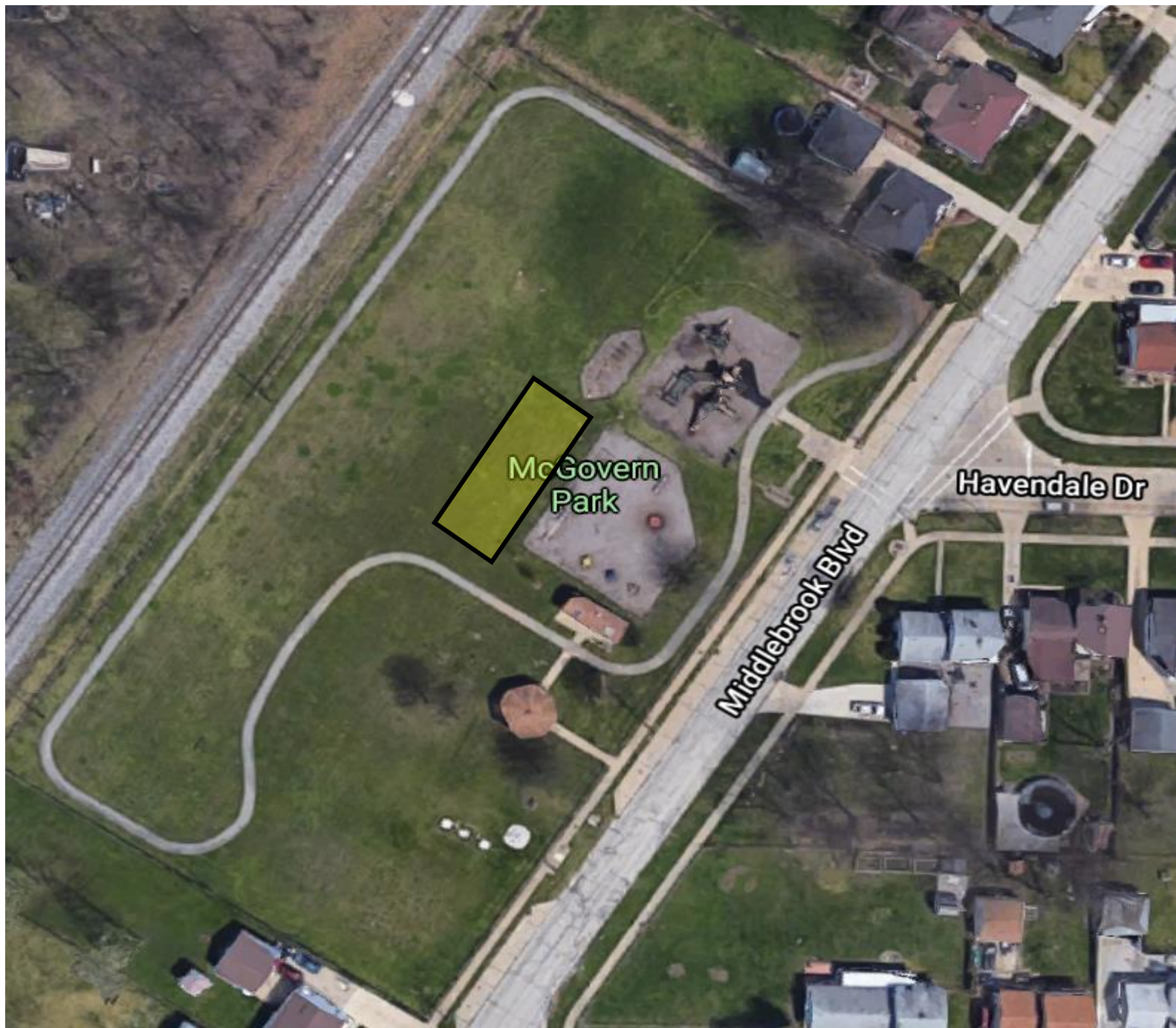




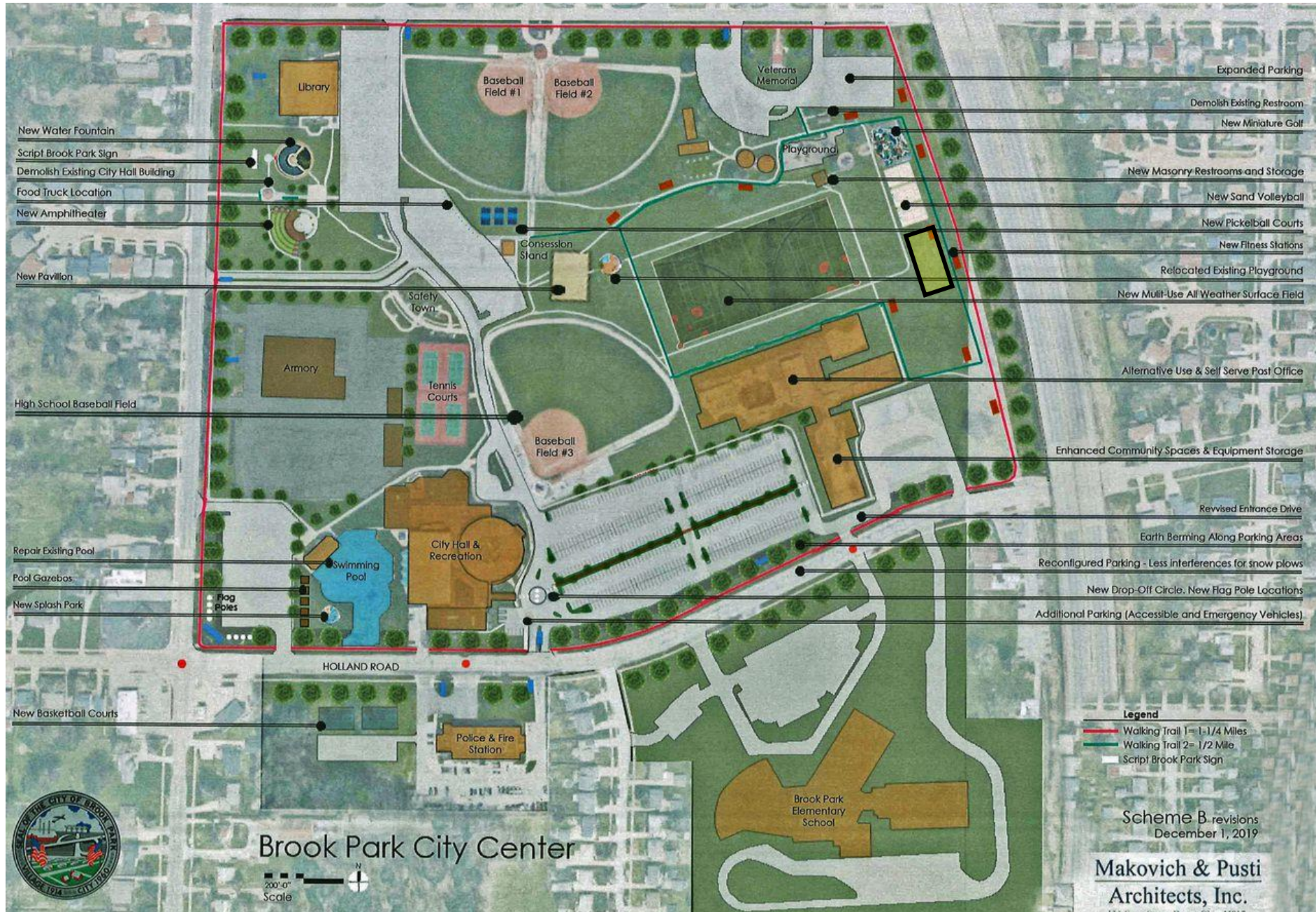

SWAY FUN® GLIDER

The SwayFun is an all inclusive multi-user play event. Children work together by shifting their weight in unison and causing the entire unit to sway back and forth. The event allows at least enough space for two wheelchair users to enjoy the group fun.

**Cost \$32K
Installed**

Features:

- First wheelchair-accessible/inclusive glider to meet all safety standards
- Accommodates children using a mobility device. Room for wheelchairs and/or strollers.
- Gentle swaying motion perfect for all ages provides vestibular input
- Table position allows those using wheelchairs to make the entire play feature sway back and forth.

This multi-user swaying component is available attached to a ramped PlayBooster structure or as an independent play component accessed by a ramp.

This group glider allows greater accessibility for children of all abilities, especially those with special mobility needs, access to the large swaying platform for great peer to peer play. Creates equitable access for children and grown-up companions of all abilities.

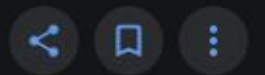
