# HONORING “MISS POPPY 2018” NICOLE ZAPTOCKY

**WHEREAS,** Nicole Zaptocky was chosen to represent the American Legion Auxiliary Unit 610 as Miss Poppy 2018; and

**WHEREAS,** Nicole Zaptocky resides at 7001 Oakwood Road in Parma Heights, Ohio and is the daughter of Beth and Brian Zaptocky, and the sister of Zachary. Nicole was born on October 9, 2008, and is a third grader at Parma Park Elementary School on Blossom Avenue in Parma Heights.; and

**WHEREAS,** Nicole Zaptocky enjoys reading books about dogs and being around all animals. Nicole plays on a traveling soccer team in the summers and when not playing soccer she spends her weekends camping with her family. She has been a Jr. Member of the Auxiliary for 4 years and has helped with baking cookies for the Wade Park VMAC, filling purses for the women in rehab and filling “Dirty Bags” for the Veterans. Nicole will be in the Memorial Day Parade and will lead the Pledge of Allegiance at the Memorial Service; and

**WHEREAS,** The red paper Poppy is made by disabled veterans at the Ohio Veterans Home in Sandusky, Ohio. The red poppy is a symbol, in tribute to those veterans who have died and willingly served their country in the past seven decades. The workers are paid for each poppy made and the materials are provided free by the state organization. After constructing the poppies, they are sold to Auxiliary Units all across the state. Auxiliary members then offer these flowers to the public and share the story behind the little red Poppy with 100% of all donations being used to aid and assist veterans and their children. These funds support military families, hospitalized veterans, and also provide essential items for homeless veterans; and

**WHEREAS,** The American Legion Auxiliary Unit 610 designates May 19<sup>th</sup> and May 20<sup>th</sup> as the official “Poppy Days” in the City of Brook Park in honor and in memory of all who have willingly served and sacrificed their lives to secure our freedom.
