AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO CREATE A "SAFE EXCHANGE ZONE" BY THE BROOK PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, many of our Brook Park residents buy, sell, or trade items in private party transactions and need a safe environment to do so; and

WHEREAS, a "Safe Exchange Zone" will provide a safe environment, with designated parking spaces at the police station and 24-hour video surveillance; and

WHEREAS, even with safe exchange zones, please keep these safety tips in mind when conducting such transactions:

- Do not go to a transaction alone
- Make sure a friend or family member is aware of the transaction details
- Insist on meeting in a public area like our safe transaction zone
- Do not go into someone else's house, and do not allow them into yours
- Complete the transaction during daylight hours
- Be extra cautious when buying or selling valuable items such as vehicles and jewelry
- Trust your instincts and be cautious of scams

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to create a "Safe Exchange Zone" by the Brook Park Police Department, with 24-hour surveillance for our Brook Park residents to safely conduct private party transactions.

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that

all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare in the City, and for the further reason to authorize the Mayor to create a "Safe Exchange Zone"; therefore provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council it shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
