





WHEREAS, the voters in Brook Park were forced to wait in long lines, most having to wait an average of two hours to exercise their right to vote in this year's presidential election; and

WHEREAS, the Brook Park voters faced not only long lines, but inadequate parking, which also caused inconvenience to library patrons and employees; and

WHEREAS, this Council and the citizens of Brook Park are requesting an investigation as to why many of the polling places in our City were closed before the presidential election; and

WHEREAS, this Council and the citizens of Brook Park are requesting an investigation as to why only half the poll books than the normal amount (per the poll workers) were provided by the Board of Elections on November 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, this Council and the citizens are requesting an investigation as to why another poll book did not arrive until 7:00 p.m., and 14 booths were empty most of the day; and

WHEREAS, this Council is asking for a full investigation into all of these matters and request a written report as to how this occurred, whom is responsible and what can be done to prevent a reoccurrence.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: This Council believes that an investigation is warranted due to many Brook Park residents being prevented or suppressed from voting on November 3, 2020 and therefore are formally request a report on who was responsible for the planning

and execution of polling for the City of Brook Park.

SECTION 2: This Council further would like to extend an invitation to a representative from the Cuyahoga Board of Elections to come before this body and our residents to explain the process for the past election and what the board plans are to take corrective measures so that there are not disenfranchised voters in Brook Park in the future.

SECTION 2: The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to: Cuyahoga County Board of Elections.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
