WHEREAS, on or around December 5, 2019, the District and City entered into a Community Cost-Share Agreement (the "Agreement") for City's Elmdale Drainage Improvements project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, bids came in over the initial budget estimate; and

WHEREAS, it is, therefore, necessary for the parties to amend the Agreement to increase the funding allocated to the Project;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the payment and the mutual promises contained in this Amendment, the parties agree as follows:

- By execution of this Amendment, the District and City agree that the total Community Cost-Share funding allocated to the Project under the Agreement shall be increased by the amount not to exceed \$7,515.50 for an amended total funding amount of \$46,515.50, as further described in the Request for Budget Modification attached hereto as Exhibit "A."
- The provisions of this Amendment are hereby incorporated into the Agreement, as if fully rewritten therein. All terms used herein shall be defined and construed in the manner set forth in the Agreement. Except as otherwise provided in, or as otherwise necessary or appropriate to give effect to the terms of this Amendment, all the provisions, terms and conditions contained in the Agreement and not inconsistent with this Amendment shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect. In the event of any conflict between the Agreement and this Amendment, the terms, conditions, and provisions of this Amendment shall control.
