INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR ORCUTT

AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT THE DONATION AND TRANSFER OF LAND KNOWN AS PERMANENT PARCEL NO. 344-03-103, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Margaret $W$. Young, owner of the property located on West $149^{\text {th }}$ Street, Brook Park, Ohio known as Permanent Parcel No. 344-03-103 has offered to donate and transfer this property to the City of Brook Park; and

WHEREAS, the donation and transfer of this property located on West $149^{\text {th }}$ Street, Brook Park, Ohio known as Permanent Parcel No. 344-03-103 would be beneficial to the City of Brook Park for future economic development; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept the donation of PPN 344-03-103, a parcel of property which is further described and attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully rewritten as Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2: The City of Brook Park shall pay $\$ 1.00$ for PPN 344-03-103.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason to authorize the Mayor to accept the donation and transfer of property located on West $149^{\text {th }}$ Street, Brook Park, Ohio
