ORDINANCE NO. 9967-2015, AMENDING SECTIONS 1705.01, 1705.02, 1713.02(a) OF THE BROOK PARK CODIFIED ORDINANCES PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE ANNUAL INCOME TAX RATE FROM TWO PERCENT (2%) TO TWO AND ONE-HALF PERCENT (2 ½%); SAID ONE-HALF PERCENT (.5%) INCREASE SHALL BE LEVIED BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2016 TO BE LIMITED TO FIVE (5) CONSECUTIVE YEARS AND ALL TAXES COLLECTED FOR SAID INCREASE SHALL BE RESTRICTED TO EXPENDITURES FOR ROAD REPAIRS, ROAD CONSTRUCTION, SEWER REPAIRS AND SEWER CONSTRUCTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY Introduced by Council Members D'Amico, Mencini, Burgio, Higgins and Council President Patten
