

The meeting was called to order by Council President Astorino at 8:42 p.m. who read the meeting notice, the clerk called the roll and the following Members of Council answered:

Also in attendance were Law Director Horvath, Service Director Cayet, Mayor Coyne, Finance Director Cingle, Building Commissioner Hurst, Engineer Piatak.

INTRODUCTION OF RESOLUTIONS AND ORDINANCES: (FIRST READING):

1. ORDINANCE NO. 10017-2016, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE LODGE NO. 15 (PATROL OFFICERS) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY Introduced by Mayor Coyne
Motion by Mr. Salvatore, supported by Mr. Mencini, to suspend.
ROLL CALL: AYES: Salvatore, Mencini, Scott, Burgio
NAYS: McCormick, Powers
ABSTENTION: Troyer. The motion failed with a vote of 4-2 with one abstention.

Motion by Mr. Mencini, supported by Mr. Scott, to suspend.
ROLL CALL: AYES: Mencini, Scott, Burgio, Salvatore
NAYS: Troyer, Powers, McCormick. The motion failed with a vote of 4-3.

Motion by Amr. Burgio, supported by Mr. Mencini, to suspend.
ROLL CALL: AYES: Burgio, Mencini, Salvatore, Scott
NAYS: McCormick, Powers, Troyer. The motion failed with a vote of 4-3.

- 4. ORDINANCE NO. 10020-2016, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE TEAMSTERS UNION LOCAL 436 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY Introduced by Mayor Coyne

Motion by Mr. Mencini, supported by Mr. Scott, to suspend.

ROLL CALL: AYES: Mencini, Scott, Burgio, Salvatore.

NAYS: Troyer, Powers, McCormick. The motion failed with a vote of 4-3.

Mr. Astorino stated Ordinance No. 10020-2016 has had its First Reading.

- 5. ORDINANCE NO. 10021-2016, AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO PROVIDE ADJUSTMENTS IN COMPENSATION FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY, OTHER THAN ELECTED OFFICIALS OR THOSE COVERED UNDER NEGOTIATED LABOR CONTRACTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY Introduced by Mayor Coyne (**Administrative Employees**)

Motion by Mrs. McCormick, supported by Mr. Troyer, to amend all part-time positions currently at \$8.10 an hour to \$10.00 an hour.

ROLL CALL: AYES: McCormick, Troyer, Powers, Mencini

NAYS: Scott, Burgio, Salvatore. The motion carried with a vote of 4-3.

Motion by Mrs. McCormick, supported by Mr. Troyer, to increase schedule 142.07 - Auxiliary Police minimum from \$10.20 to \$13.00 for the years 2016-2017.

ROLL CALL: AYES: McCormick, Troyer, Powers, Mencini, Scott, Burgio, Salvatore

NAYS: None. The motion carried.

Mr. Astorino stated Ordinance No. 10020-2016 has had its First Reading.

Motion by Mr. Salvatore, supported by Mr. Mencini, to go into Executive Session for the purpose of Negotiations - Personnel Matters.

Mr. Salvatore withdrew his motion and Mr. Mencini, withdrew his support.

There being no further business to come before this meeting Council President Astorino declared this meeting adjourned at 8:58 p.m.
