Mr. Presley responded that's is one (1) quote but can get competing quotes.

Mr. Mencini stated good presentation and technology advances every day and this committee has been fantastic with responding to questions. With the new technology still having problems with streaming and so forth. Will this be for long term?

Mr. Presley responded there are five (5) cabinets connected to computers, printers, etc. There will be a lot of testing wires to see where they go, meaning lot of labor. The wires in the closets will not be included in this update.

Mr. Gonzalez stated there are a couple of speakers on the outside of the waterpark that are controlled inside the waterpark building. There is one (1) speaker on the mini-gym that can be heard at times; will that mini-gym amplifier or pool amplifier be able to play music outside, while enjoying the waterpark?

Mr. Presley concurred with the one (1) speaker and stated will be adding more speakers, per the quote.
