AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 153.01(d)
OF THE BROOK PARK CODIFIED ORDINANCES
ENTITLED 'VACATIONS,'
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: Section 153.01(d) of the Brook Park Codified Ordinances, as enacted by Ordinance No. 11100-2019 passed July 2, 2019 is hereby amended to read as follows:

153.01(d)

All department heads shall schedule vacations so that they can be taken within the calendar year. However, upon a department head's recommendation and approval, any unused vacation, because of a heavy workload or emergencies within a City department, may be taken by December 31st of the following year. This provision shall only be in effect until December 31, 2021. Beginning January 1, 2022, upon a department head's recommendation and approval, any unused vacation, because of a heavy workload or emergencies within a City department may be taken within a ninety-day grace period in the following calendar year. Under no circumstances shall the grace period be extended beyond March 31 of the year following the year of vacation.

- SECTION 2: Former Section 153.01(d) of the Brook Park Codified Ordinances as enacted by Ordinance No. 11100-2019 passed July 2, 2019, is hereby expressly repealed.
- SECTION 3 It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason of amending section 153.01(d) of the Brook Park

Codified Ordinances; therefore provided this ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
