AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR TREE INVENTORY SERVICES, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE LOWEST AND/OR BEST BIDDER TO PROVIDE THE TREE INVENTORY SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park applied for a grant with the County of Cuyahoga for a Healthy Urban Tree Canopy Program and was awarded a grant in the amount of \$46,085.29, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, said grant has been approved for improving Brook Park's Tree Canopy; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized by the City of Brook Park to advertise for bids for tree inventory services, and the Mayor is further authorized to enter into a contract with the lowest and/or best bidder for tree inventory services, not to exceed \$30,000.00.

SECTION 2: The money needed for the aforesaid transaction shall be paid from Fund No. 100; appropriated or to be appropriated for said purpose.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason to authorize the Mayor to advertise for bids for



tree inventory services, and to enter into a contract with the lowest and/or best bidder; therefore provided this ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
