AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
DISPOSE OF OBSOLETE CITY RECREATION EQUIPMENT,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park has certain recreation equipment that is obsolete, in disrepair, or past it's shelf life; and

WHEREAS, said recreation equipment has little or no value and it is not feasible to sell said property; and

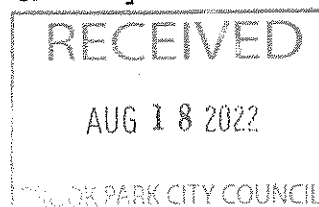
WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Brook Park to dispose of said equipment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of obsolete city recreation equipment, a list of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason to dispose of obsolete city recreation equipment therefore provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
