AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BROOK PARK TO ACCEPT DONATED FUNDS

WHEREAS, Mr. Patrick M. Morsillo, a former resident and longtime owner of the Greater Cleveland Auto Auction wishes to give back to the city and those who serve and protect our community by providing a monetary donation in the amount of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000) Dollars to the Brook Park Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Morsillo wishes that a portion of said donation be used for the purchase, necessary protective equipment and training of a Police K-9 and his/her accompanying Police handler; and

WHEREAS, all remaining/leftover funds from said donation are to be used for training and or equipment for Brook Park Police Department patrol officers; and

WHEREAS, all expenditures of this donation are to be used for the sole purposes listed in this ordinance; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Council of the City of Brook Park hereby authorizes the City to accept this monetary donation and to disburse the funds as requested by the donor.

<u>SECTION 2:</u> This Ordinance authorizes the sum of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) dollars to be received and recorded into fund No. 100, cost center No. 412 (Police Department) of the General Fund.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further purpose of allowing the City to receive and disburse said funding, provided that this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take affect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
