ORDINANCE NO. 11341 - 2023

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE WEDO PARK STORM WATER BASIN PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Wedo Park Storm Water (Project) has been identified as a Project to help manage storm water runoff within the City of Brook Park;

WHEREAS, the Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORSD) has indicated that costs incurred by the City for this Project would be eligible for reimbursement through the Community Cost Share Account;

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park is prepared to commence with the bidding phase of the Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

<u>SECTION 1</u>: The Mayor is authorized to advertise for bids for the Wedo Park Storm Water Basin Project.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: The money needed to complete the aforesaid transaction shall be paid from the Sewer Improvement Fund No. 459, theretofore appropriated or to be appropriated for said purpose.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety of said City, and for the further reason that City Council deems it necessary to proceed with the Bidding Phase of the Wedo Park Storm Water Basin Project as soon as possible, therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected

to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
