

ORDINANCE NO. 11365 - 2083

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 11350-2023 TO INCLUDE ADDITIONAL ROADWAY REPAIRS IN THE 2023 EQUIPMENT AND GENERAL PAVEMENT SERVICES PROGRAM (CONTRACT 202303), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The 2023 Equipment and General Pavement Services Program (Contract 202303) shall be amended to include Item #1 listed on Attachment "A-3" of Ordinance 11318-2023 adopted on March 21, 2023, by this Council.

SECTION 2: The 2023 Equipment and General Pavement Services Program (Contract 202303) shall be amended to also include the repair/resurfacing of Shelby Drive, from Wedo Park to Hummel Road and Ashland Drive from Shelby Drive through the Harrison Drive intersection. The cost of said repair/resurfacing has been estimated to be \$206,381.24, as indicated on Exhibit 1.

<u>SECTION 3</u>: The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to execute a Change Order to Contract 202303 as necessary to effectuate the additional work identified in Sections 1 and 2 above.

<u>SECTION 4</u>: The money needed to complete the aforesaid transaction shall be paid from Fund Nos. 240, 242 and 549, theretofore appropriated or to be appropriated for said purpose.

SECTION 5: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



SECTION 6: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety of said City, and for the further reason that City Council deems it necessary to proceed with the 2023 Equipment and General Pavement Services Program as soon as possible, therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

- *All signage, barricades and traffic control by included.

SCOPE OF WORK-

- *Mill the existing asphalt/concrete pavement to a depth of 3.0" and remove from site.
- *Sweep clean free of all dust and debris.
- *Determine full depth repairs.
- *Install single chip seal.
- *Install ODOT #448-1 intermediate asphalt to a compacted thickness of 1.50"
- *Apply ODOT #407 tack coat at a rate of .10 gal/sy.
- *Install ODOT #448-2 surface asphalt to a compacted thickness of 1.50"
- *Gutter seal all curbs and castings with ODOT Type IV sealer.
- **NOTE- All repairs are for estimating purposes only and may increase or decrease based on pavement evaluation after milling, and/or proof roll.
