ORDINANCE NO: 11519-2026

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR ORCUTT

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
DISPOSE OF AN OBSOLETE CITY VEHICLE THAT IS UNSAFE
AND NO LONGER ROAD WORTHY,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park has a 1985 Ford L8000 plow truck that is no longer road worthy, in disrepair, and is unsafe to operate; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has set up an account with McMahan's Scrapping that will offer a fair market value based upon daily metal pricing; and


WHEREAS, McMahan Scrapping will provide the towing service and deduct the towing cost from the gross proceeds; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Brook Park to dispose of said vehicle and receive the value for same.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of obsolete city vehicles that are unsafe and no longer road worthy by allowing them to be transported by McMahan Scrapping as listed in the attached Exhibit "A."

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.



SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason to dispose of an obsolete city vehicle; therefore provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
