ORDINANCE NO: 11539-2026

INTRODUCED BY: MAYOR ORCUTT

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO USE A FORFEITED VEHICLE FOR TRAINING PURPOSES, AND FOR THE MAYOR TO DISPOSE OF THE REMAINING SCRAP PARTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park has a 2007 Honda Accord, VIN 1HGCM56317A122758, a forfeited vehicle that the Police Department wishes to use for training purposes, and afterward to dispose of the remaining scrap parts of the vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Service Director has set up an account with Berea Metals & Recycling at 5201 West 165th Street, Brook Park, OH 44142 that will offer a fair market value based upon daily metal pricing; and

WHEREAS, Berea Metals & Recycling will provide the towing service and deduct the towing cost from the gross proceeds; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Brook Park to dispose of said vehicle and receive the value for same.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Police Department is hereby authorized and directed to use a forfeited vehicle for training purposes.

SECTION 2: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to dispose of forfeited vehicles, after being used by the Police Department for training purposes, by allowing them to be transported by Berea Metals & Recycling.

SECTION 3: Proceeds from the sale of the scrap vehicle shall be deposited into Law Enforcement Fund 270.


SECTION 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason to allow the Police Department to use a forfeited vehicle for training purposes and subsequently for the City to dispose of the remaining scrap parts; therefore provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


