AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 141.02 OF THE BROOK PARK CODIFIED ORDINANCES ENTITLED "COMPOSITION; EXECUTIVE HEAD," AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: Section 141.02 of the Brook Park Codified Ordinances, as amended by Ordinance No. 11451-2024, passed December 17, 2024, reading as follows:

141.02 COMPOSITION; EXECUTIVE HEAD.

- (a) The Police Department shall consist of a Police Chief and not more than forty-three regular police officers.
- (b) There is hereby established within the Police Department one Police Chief, one Police Captain, not more than four Police Sergeants, and not more than four Police Lieutenants, and a Detective Bureau. Such officers shall be appointed by the Director of Public Safety from the regular full-time membership of the Police Department.
- (c) Under the direction of the Mayor, the Director of Public Safety shall be the executive head of the Police Department. He shall have all powers and duties connected with and incident to the appointment, regulation, and government of such Department, except as otherwise provided by law.

Is hereby amended to read:

- (a) The Police Department shall consist of a Police Chief and not more than forty-three regular police officers.
- (b) There is hereby established within the Police Department one Police Chief, one Police Captain, not ~~moreless~~ than four Police Sergeants, and not ~~moreless~~ than four Police Lieutenants, and a Detective Bureau. Such officers shall be appointed by the Director of Public Safety from the regular full-time membership of the Police Department.

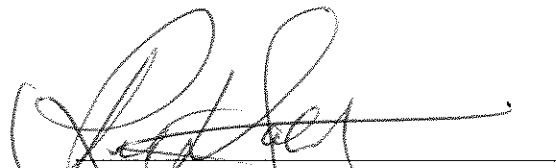
- (c) Under the direction of the Mayor, the Director of Public Safety shall be the executive head of the Police Department. He shall have all powers and duties connected with an incident to the appointment, regulation, and government of such Department, except as otherwise provided by law.

SECTION 2: Section 141.02 of the Brook Park Codified Ordinances as amended by Ordinance No. 11451-2024, passed December 17, 2024 is hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of said City; therefore, provided this ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

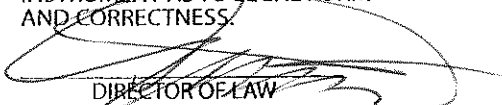
