AN ORDINANCE  
AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM  
THE BROOK PARK FOOD PANTRY TO AUDREY'S OUTREACH AS A DONATION,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park previously operated a food pantry for the benefit of the citizens of Brook Park; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park received donations in the amount of \$4,765.57 which were placed in Fund No. 259 for the purpose of supporting the Food Bank;

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park ceased to operate a food pantry leaving the donated funds in Fund No. 259, serving no reasonable purpose; and

WHEREAS, Audrey's Outreach provides that assistance to families in need and is an independent Ohio non-profit organization for which such donations are vital; and

WHEREAS, these funds could be used to benefit the citizens of Brook Park by their donation to Audrey's Outreach;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: Therefore all funds held in Fund No. 259 are to be paid to Audrey's Outreach Lunch Sack Program.

SECTION 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to pay the funds held in Fund No. 259 to Audrey's Outreach as a donation.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for reason to allow the City to transfer the funds from the Brook Park Food Pantry to Audrey's Outreach Lunch Sack Program; provided this ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
