AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO MAKE A DISTRIBUTION FROM THE MAYOR'S  
COURT FUND TO THE DOMESTIC VIOLENCE & CHILD ADVOCACY CENTER

WHEREAS, the Domestic Violence & Child Advocacy Center provides services in Berea Court to our residents for victims of domestic violence to prevent and reduce child sexual abuse, teen dating violence, intimate partner violence, domestic violence, stalking and elder abuse; and

WHEREAS, the Domestic Violence & Child Advocacy Center provides services such as court preparation, advocacy, court escorts, safety planning, crisis intervention, information and referrals for over 20 years to Brook Park residents; and

WHEREAS, the Domestic Violence & Child Advocacy Center served 51 Brook Park residents in the Berea Court System in 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Domestic Violence & Child Advocacy Center is now in need of funding and is hereby requesting the City of Brook Park to help victims of domestic violence by appropriating \$5,000.00 from the Mayor's Court Fund;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Council of the City of Brook Park hereby authorizes the City to appropriate funds from the Mayor's Court Fund to the Domestic Violence & Child Advocacy Center for the benefit of residents of Brook Park who are victims of domestic violence.

SECTION 2: Further this Ordinance authorizes the sum of \$5,000.00 for this expense from the Mayor's Court Fund.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Sections 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
