**AN ORDINANCE  
AUTHORIZING THE CONSULTING ENGINEER TO  
PREPARE AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE YEAR 2017  
OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR  
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) FOR FINANCIAL  
ASSISTANCE ON THE HOLLAND ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Brook Park desires to seek financial assistance from the State Issue I Infrastructure Bond Program for the funding of the Holland Road Reconstruction Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the existing roadway is in a state of disrepair and is in need of major rehabilitation; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Brook Park is planning to make capital improvements to the roads within the City; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1:** The Consulting Engineer is hereby authorized to prepare a Capital Improvements Report and Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) Application for Financial Assistance, for the Holland Road Reconstruction Project. The Consulting Engineer shall be paid a lump sum fee of \$3,700.00.

**SECTION 2:** The money needed to complete the aforesaid transaction shall be paid from funds theretofore appropriated or to be appropriated for said purpose.

**SECTION 3:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 4:** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety of said City, therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
