**AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE CONSULTING ENGINEER TO
PREPARE A JOINT APPLICATION WITH THE CITY OF
MIDDLEBURG HEIGHTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE YEAR 2019
OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) FOR
FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE ON THE SHELDON ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Cities of Brook Park and Middleburg Heights desire to jointly seek financial assistance from the State Issue I Infrastructure Bond Program for the funding of the Sheldon Road Resurfacing Project; and

WHEREAS, the existing roadway is in need of repairs and resurfacing and the Cities of Brook Park and Middleburg Heights are planning to make improvements to the section of Sheldon Road between Eastland Road and Engle Road; and

WHEREAS, the County of Cuyahoga has agreed to contribute 50% of the eligible construction costs up to a maximum of \$250,000; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Consulting Engineer is hereby authorized to prepare a Capital Improvements Report and Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) Application for Financial Assistance, for the Sheldon Road Resurfacing Project. The Consulting Engineer shall be paid a lump sum fee of \$3,900.00.

SECTION 2: The money needed to complete the aforesaid transaction shall be paid from funds theretofore appropriated or to be appropriated for said purpose.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety of said City, therefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
