AN ORDINANCE
RETAINING AND EMPLOYING THE
LAW FIRM OF WALTER HAVERFIELD,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park may employ attorneys to provide professional and legal services, acting as co-counsel with the Law Director; and

WHEREAS, the City has specialized issues, requiring specialized, technical and legal assistance employee-related and employee benefits-related matters; and

WHEREAS, the results of these matters will have a very significant fiscal and operational impact on the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that certain technical, professional and legal assistance will enable it to participate more effectively in these matters; and

WHEREAS, Marc J. Bloch of Walter Haverfield will provide such technical, professional and legal assistance and have the necessary skills, experience and abilities to provide such assistance in the field of employee-related and employee benefits-related matters and representation of the City in all matters therein related.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That the law firm of Walter Haverfield, is hereby retained to represent the City in all matters concerning employee-related and employee benefits-related, including but not limited to labor negotiations, arbitration, mediation and any other areas consistent with this specific area of law.

SECTION 2: The money needed for the aforesaid transaction shall be paid from funds theretofore appropriated for said purposes.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason hire the law firm of Walter Haverfield; therefore this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
