AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
CONTRACT WITH FABRIZI TRUCKING AND PAVING COMPANY, INC.,
FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO THE RUPLE PARKWAY
AND SURROUNDING AREAS,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, soil erosion and geological events have caused the closure of Ruple Parkway in the City of Brook Park; and

WHEREAS, emergency measures are needed to remedy Ruple Parkway and surrounding areas;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to Section 7.04(h) of the Charter of the City of Brook Park, the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Fabrizi Trucking and Paving Company, Inc., without public bidding for the emergency repair to Ruple Parkway, the bin wall supporting said road and area, and additional slope stabilization, a quote of the transaction is further described in attached Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2: The money needed for the aforesaid transaction shall be paid from funds theretofore appropriated or to be appropriated for said purpose in the amount not to exceed \$36,050.00.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason to provide the necessary emergency repairs to Ruple Parkway, bin wall and additional slope stabilization; therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
