AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
GREATER CLEVELAND AUTO AUCTION, PUBLIC AUCTIONEERS,
FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISPOSING OF POLICE VEHICLES,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Greater Cleveland Auto Auction will provide the City of Brook Park with Auction services for the disposal of three 2005 Ford Taurus vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Greater Cleveland Auto Auction will charge the City of Brook Park a selling fee of \$75.00 per auctioned item; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Brook Park that said agreement be entered into;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Greater Cleveland Auto Auction, for the purpose of disposing of the following vehicles at a public sale:

- (1) Ford Taurus Vin #1FAFP53295A202200
- (1) Ford Taurus Vin #1FAFP53245A202203
- (1) Ford Taurus Vin #1FAFP53255A202209

SECTION 2: The money needed for the aforesaid transaction shall be paid from funds theretofore appropriated for said purpose.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason to provide for an agreement between Greater Cleveland Auto Auction and the City of Brook Park; therefore this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
