AN ORDINANCE  
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A  
CONTRACT WITH HULL & ASSOCIATES  
WITHOUT PUBLIC BIDDING FOR PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council deems it necessary for the City to enter into a contract with Hull & Associates to perform project management services for the Local Brownfield Cleanup Program under Chapter 942 of the Brook Park Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, said study is of such a highly specialized nature, requiring the exercise of peculiar skill and aptitude, and that said contract is properly deemed excepted from the bidding requirements ordinarily associated with the letting of public contracts.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Hull & Associates, to perform environmental project management services for the Local Brownfield Cleanup Program.

SECTION 2: The money needed for the aforesaid transaction shall be paid from funds theretofore appropriated for said purposes; provided that, in no event shall the total amount to be paid under said contract not to exceed \$50,000.00.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the
