**AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE CONSULTING ENGINEER TO
PREPARE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE
SNOW ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT (PID 100238)
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Snow Road Resurfacing Project (PID 100238) includes the face of curb to face of curb pavement resurfacing of Snow Road from SR-237 to West 130th Street.

WHEREAS, the Snow Road Resurfacing Project (PID 100238) has been awarded funds through NOACA Provisional Transportation Asset Management (PTAM) Program eligible for the ODOT State Fiscal Year 2016.

WHEREAS, this project is an ODOT-let project with NOACA providing 80% funding for eligible construction costs.

WHEREAS, the project will be administered in accordance with the ODOT-let Policy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Consulting Engineer is hereby authorized to prepare plans and specifications and provide services in accordance with letter proposal dated August 31, 2015 (Attachment A) for the Snow Road Resurfacing Project (PID 100238). The Consulting Engineer shall be paid a lump sum fee of \$78,075.00 for Stage 3 Plans, \$26,185.00 for PS&E Plans and \$10,420.00 for Design Exception and Recommended Mitigation (if authorized), in accordance with said letter proposal.

SECTION 2: The Mayor is further authorized to enter into agreements as may be necessary and appropriate to complete the project.

SECTION 3: The money needed to complete the aforesaid transaction shall be paid from funds theretofore appropriated or to be appropriated for said purpose.

SECTION 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety of said City, and for the further reason that Council deems it necessary to complete the engineering for the Snow Road Resurfacing Project; therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
