A RESOLUTION

GRANTING PROJECT APPROVAL FOR THE POWER AND LIGHTING DESIGN OF THE CITY OF BROOK PARK'S CENTRAL PARK COMPLEX, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY


WHEREAS, Pam Haberman of Makovich & Pusti, filed a request for approval of the power and lighting design of the city of Brook Park's Central Park Complex with the Brook Park Planning Commission at a public hearing on April 4, 2022, to the Brook Park Planning Commission, which it approved and referred to Council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: The Council of the City of Brook Park approves the proposed project design for the power and lighting of the City of Brook Park's Central Park Complex.

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further purpose of granting project approval for the power and lighting design of the City's Central Park Complex; therefore, provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
