A RESOLUTION

DESIGNATING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER AS BREAST CANCER AWARENESS IN THE CITY OF BROOK PARK, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, breast cancer is the most common cancer in women in the United States and second leading cause of death in women; and

WHEREAS, Southwest Hospital joined with the City of Brook Park for breast cancer awareness.

- City of Brook Park employees were provided with tshirts to wear on Fridays to promote breast cancer awareness in October.
- The Cities of Berea and Strongsville joined Brook Park and Southwest General in support of breast cancer awareness.
- The City of Brook Park's gazebo is lit in pink during the month of October.

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park hereby designates the month of October, and every October thereafter, as Breast Cancer Awareness Month in the City of Brook Park; and

WHEREAS, the City along with Southwest General Health Center is reminding and urging women to schedule a mammogram screening; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: That this Council does hereby designate the month of October as Breast Cancer Awareness Month in Brook Park and will show our support in lighting up our pavilion with pink lights and wearing pink on Fridays.

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City and to show support for breast cancer awareness, provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
