A RESOLUTION

DECLARING APRIL 28, 2024 WORKERS MEMORIAL DAY IN BROOK PARK, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on April 28, 1971, the Occupational Safety and Health Act went into effect, promising every worker the fundamental right to a safe job; and

WHEREAS, each year, thousands of workers are killed and many more suffer injury or illness because of their jobs; and

WHEREAS, each April we observe Workers' Memorial Day as a day to remember those who have been injured and died on the job; and

WHEREAS, Workers' Memorial Day is observed in nearly 100 countries; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park has a strong blue collar tradition which values working people and their safety; and

WHEREAS, Workers' Memorial Day provides an opportunity to renew our commitment to workplace safety; and

WHEREAS, every worker in Brook Park and beyond deserves to return home safe and healthy at the end of each workday

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

- The City of Brook Park's Council does hereby declare April 28, 2024 as Workers' Memorial Day in Brook Park.
- SECTION 2: We encourage all Brook Park residents to remember those who have been injured and died on the job, and recommit ourselves to encouraging and fighting for safe workplaces.
- **SECTION 3:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that

resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an SECTION 4: emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason to declare April 28, 2024 Workers' Memorial Day in Brook Park; therefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
