## A RESOLUTION DECLARING AUGUST 7TH PURPLE HEART DAY IN THE CITY OF BROOK PARK

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park in the State of Ohio has always supported its military and military veteran populations; and

WHEREAS, the Purple Heart is the oldest military decoration in present use and was initially created as the Badge of Military Merit by General George Washington in 1782; and

WHEREAS, the Purple Heart was the first American service award or decoration made available to the common soldier and is specifically awarded to members of the United States Armed Forces who have been wounded or paid the ultimate sacrifice in combat with a declared enemy of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the mission of the Military Order of the Purple Heart is to foster an environment of goodwill among the combat-wounded veteran members and their families, promote patriotism, support legislative initiatives, and most importantly - make sure we never forget; and

WHEREAS, the Cleveland metropolitan area has a large, highly decorated veteran population including many Purple Heart recipients; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park is home to the 3rd Battalion, 25th Regiment of the United States Marine Corps Reserves, of which forty-six Marines and two Navy Corpsmen serving with the battalion in Iraq from 2005 to 2006 were killed in action; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park appreciates the sacrifices our Purple Heart recipients made in defending our freedoms and believe it is important that we acknowledge them for their courage and show them the honor and support they have earned.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

**SECTION 1:** The Council of the City of Brook Park hereby designates August 7th as Purple Heart Day in Brook Park.

SECTION 2: The Council and the City of Brook Park will honor Purple Heart recipients in a ceremony to be held on August 7, 2016, at Kennedy Park.

SECTION 3: The Council encourages the participation in the ceremony by members of the local Military Order of the Purple Heart (MOPH), as well as all veterans and veterans organizations, and active-duty members of the United States Armed Forces.

SECTION 4: The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and instructed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to be posted on the City's website.

SECTION 5: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
