RESOLUTION NO. 8-202

A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR
TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ODOT
CONTRACT FOR ROAD SALT,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park (hereinafter referred to as the "Political Subdivision") hereby submits this written agreement to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT) annual road salt bid in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5513.01(B) and hereby agrees to all of the following terms and conditions in its participation of the ODOT road salt contract:

- a. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions established by ODOT in the road salt contract and acknowledges that upon award of the contract by the Director of ODOT it shall be bound by all such terms and conditions included in the contract; and
- b. The Political Subdivision hereby acknowledges that upon the Director of ODOT's signing of the road salt contract, it shall effectively form a contract between the awarded salt supplier and the Political Subdivision; and
- c. The Political Subdivision agrees to be solely responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in the ODOT road salt contract and agrees to hold the Department of Transportation harmless for any claims, actions, expenses, or other damages arising out of the Political Subdivision's participation in the road salt contract; and
- d. The Political Subdivision hereby requests through this participation agreement a total of 3,000 tons of Sodium

- Chloride (Road Salt) of which the Political Subdivision agrees to purchase from its awarded salt supplier at the delivered bid price per ton awarded by the Director of ODOT; and
- e. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to purchase a minimum of 90% of its above-requested salt quantities from its awarded salt supplier during the contract's effective period; and
- f. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to place orders with and directly pay the awarded salt supplier on a net 30 basis for all road salt it receives pursuant to ODOT salt contract; and
- q. The Political Subdivision acknowledges that should it wish to rescind this participation agreement it will do so by written, emailed request no later than Friday, April 29 by 12:00 p.m. The written, emailed request to rescind this participation agreement must be received by the ODOT Office of Contract Sales, Purchasing Section email: Contracts.Purchasing@dot.ohio.gov by the deadline. The Department, upon receipt, will respond that it has received the request and that it has effectively removed the Political Subdivision's participation request. Furthermore, it is the sole responsibility of the Political Subdivision to ensure ODOT has received this participation agreement as well as the receipt of any request to rescind this participation agreement. The Department shall not be held responsible or liable for failure to receive a Political Subdivision's participation agreement and/or a Political Subdivision's request to rescind its participation agreement.
- NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the following authorized person(s) that this participation agreement for the ODOT road salt contract is hereby approved, funding has been authorized, and the Political Subdivision agrees to the above terms and conditions regarding participation on the ODOT salt contract:
- **SECTION 1:** The Mayor is hereby authorized to participate in the ODOT Road Salt Contract.
- **SECTION 2:** That the funds for the purpose of the aforesaid expenditure have been appropriated or to be appropriated and shall be paid from the General Fund/Snow Removal Fund No. 432.
- SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this

Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

This Resolution is hereby declared to be an SECTION 4: emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City and to authorize the Mayor to participate in the ODOT Road Salt provided this Resolution receives Contract; therefore five (5) members elected to affirmative vote of at least Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
