A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN
ALL-HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN WITH CUYAHOGA COUNTY,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park, Cuyahoga County, Ohio is most vulnerable to natural and human-made hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threatens to public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Cuyahoga county Office of emergency Management in cooperation with other county departments, and officials and citizens of the City of Brook Park; and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural hazards that face the County and its municipal governments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: The Cuyahoga County 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the City of Brook Park.

SECTION 2: The respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the Cuyahoga county 2017-2022 All-Hazards Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended activities assigned to them.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be and emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the said City and enter an All Hazards Mitigation Plan with the County; provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

A RESOLUTION
ADOPTING THE "2007 COUNTYWIDE ALL NATURAL HAZARDS
MITIGATION PLAN FOR CUYAHOGA COUNTY,"
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, hazard mitigation is any sustainable action taken to reduce or eliminate damage from future disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires all communities that desire to apply for mitigation programs to have an all-natural hazard mitigation plan; and

WHEREAS, the all-natural hazard mitigation plan must meet the criteria established by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

WHEREAS, The Cuyahoga County Board of Commissioners received a grant for the Cuyahoga County Division of Emergency Services to prepare such a mitigation plan which is entitled the "2007 Countywide All Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan for Cuyahoga County" and

WHEREAS, there must be documentation that the plan has been formally adopted by the Council of the City of Brook Park requesting approval of the plan; and

WHEREAS, each jurisdiction requesting approval of the plan must document that the plan has been formally adopted; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Brook Park acts upon the recommendations of the Department of Public Safety of the City of Brook Park which has reviewed the "2007 Countywide All Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan For Cuyahoga County" and recommended adoption.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: The City of Brook Park does hereby adopt the "2007 Countywide All Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan for Cuyahoga County."
