PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program(s) both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park is planning to make capital improvements to Ruple Parkway, the bin wall supporting said road and area, and additional slope stabilization; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the Ohio Public Works Commission ("OPWC") programs;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the "OPWC" for funds as described above.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for further reason that Council deems it necessary to proceed with this project as quickly as possible; therefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
