**WHEREAS**, Southwest General holds recognition by the Emergency Nurses Association for an Exemplary Main Campus Emergency Department; and

**WHEREAS**, Southwest General received straight A's in excellence in hospital patient safety; and

**WHEREAS**, Southwest General is a 2017 Action Registry Platinum Performance Achievement Award Winner; and

**WHEREAS**, Southwest General holds certification from the Joint Commission Heart Failure and Primary Stroke Center; and

**WHEREAS**, Southwest General received Cigna Centers of Excellence for Joint Replacement and Cardiac Cath and Angioplasty; and

**WHEREAS**, Southwest General holds a three-star rating from the Society of Thoracic Surgeons for Coronary Artery Bypass Graft; and

**WHEREAS**, Southwest General received the Gold Quality Achievement Award from the American Heart Association's Get With The Guidelines; and

**WHEREAS**, Southwest General holds the Mission: Lifeline NSTEMI Performance Achievement Award;

**WHEREAS**, Southwest General received the American Heart Association's Get With the Guidelines-Stroke Gold Plus Achievement Award; and
