A RESOLUTION
DESIGNATING THE MONTH OF JULY AS
BUY AMERICAN MONTH
IN THE CITY OF BROOK PARK,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the month of July represents the birth of our nation;
and

WHEREAS, our nation needs a rebirth to buy American; and

WHEREAS, the United States trade deficit represents an insolvent imbalance in the exports and imports of our country; and

WHEREAS, over half of the manufactured goods bought and sold in America are imported from foreign countries; and

WHEREAS, domestic manufacturing is a critical component of job creation and economic growth; and

WHEREAS, recognizing the Fourth of July is an opportunity for Americans to reflect and celebrate the founding of the United States; and

WHEREAS, July would be an appropriate period to designate as 'Buy American Month' and send a message to our manufacturers by buying American exclusively for all year and especially in July to bring jobs back to America; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for further reason to designate the month of July, 2014, as 'Buy American Month' in the City of Brook Park; therefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
