A RESOLUTION
DESIGNATING MAY 4, 2017 AS
THE ANNUAL APPRECIATION DAY FOR FIREFIGHTERS
IN THE CITY OF BROOK PARK,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Thursday, May 4, 2017 is Firefighter Day, when firefighters' dedication and gallantry across the globe is recognized; and

WHEREAS, Firefighters in serving our community are the guardians of life and property; and

WHEREAS, Firefighters have a difficult job and we often take them for granted; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Brook Park should take a moment out of their day to show appreciation for our Firefighters by saying "Thank you;" and

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park has designated May 4, 2017, as Brook Park Firefighter Day in the City of Brook Park; and

WHEREAS, the Brook Park Neighborhood Watch is an integral part of this City and also wishes to show its support and appreciation for the Brook Park Firefighters;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: That this Council and Administration does hereby designate May 4, 2017 as the annual Firefighter Appreciation Day in the City of Brook Park and encourage citizens in our community to say "Thank You" when they see a firefighter on that day.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk of Council is hereby directed to transmit copies of this Resolution to the Fire Department.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and to designate May 4, 2017 as Firefighter Appreciation Day in the City of Brook Park; therefore provided this resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
