**A RESOLUTION
HONORING PARALYZED VETERANS,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on Memorial Day May 27, 2019 we as a nation will remember and honor people who have died while serving in the United States Armed Forces; and

WHEREAS, there are an estimated 100,000 American veterans with spinal cord injuries, catastrophic disabilities, who are paralyzed veterans; and

WHEREAS, we want you to know how much we appreciate your service and your sacrifice for our country; and

WHEREAS, be strong and know that you are in our thoughts and prayers today and every day and that you have our heartfelt respect and thanks; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Council of the City of Brook Park hereby wish to honor and show thanks and respect to all our paralyzed veterans.

SECTION 2: The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and instructed to forward certified copy of this Resolution to the Paralyzed Veterans of America, 801 Eighteenth Street, N.W. Washington, DC. 20006-3517.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason to show thanks and praise to paralyzed veterans on May 27, 2019, provided that that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
