A RESOLUTION
DECLARING SEPTEMBER BLOOD CANCER
AWARENESS MONTH IN BROOK PARK
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, blood cancers are cancers of the blood, bone marrow or lymph nodes that affect normal blood cell production or function; and

WHEREAS, nearly 1.3 million people in the U.S. are living with or in remission from a blood cancer; and

WHEREAS, last year alone The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society invested nearly \$49 million in cutting-edge research; and

WHEREAS, The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society is the leading source of free blood cancer information, education and patient support; and

WHEREAS, since the early 1960s, five year survival rates for many blood cancer patients have doubled, tripled or even quadrupled; and

WHEREAS, The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society has one goal: A world without blood cancers; and

WHEREAS, working together with The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society we can create a world without blood cancers; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: That this Council along with the Mayor does hereby designate the month of September, 2017, as Blood Cancer Awareness Month in Brook Park.

SECTION 2: The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society and surrounding City Councils.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City and to show support by declaring September 2017 as Blood Cancer Awareness Month in Brook Park; therefore, provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
