WHEREAS, Samantha Rocco was president of the Speech and Debate Team and member of the Junior State of America, where she had the opportunity to travel to Washington, DC to debate world issues during this past school year; and

WHEREAS, Samantha Rocco currently is attending Ohio State University; and

WHEREAS, this past year Samantha Rocco dedicated herself to her City as an active member of the IMPACT youth mentoring group, helped plan and attend various events through the year, and volunteered her time to help out the Brook Park Senior Citizens Club; and

WHEREAS, Samantha Rocco was honored to be chosen as a Best of Brook Park award recipient, and helped Mrs. Healy choreograph the Little Princesses; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Council of the City of Brook Park, personally and collectively wish to congratulate Samantha Rocco for being chosen Miss Brook Park 2015 and for representing the City of Brook Park.

SECTION 2: The Mayor and Council extend their congratulations and offer best wishes to Samantha Rocco in all her future endeavors and pursuits.

SECTION 3: The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to Samantha Rocco, 5377 West 151st Street, Brook Park, OH 44142.

SECTION 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason to honor Samantha Rocco, Miss Brook Park 2015; provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
