**A RESOLUTION
DESIGNATING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER, 2016
AS BREAST CANCER AWARENESS IN THE CITY OF BROOK PARK, OHIO,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, breast cancer is the most common cancer in women in the United States and second leading cause of death in women; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park hereby designates the month of October, 2016 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month in the City of Brook Park; and

WHEREAS, the City along with Southwest General Health Center is reminding and urging women to schedule a mammogram screening; and

WHEREAS, on Friday, September 30, 2016, the "Seventh Annual Celtic Club Fights Cancer will display an exhibit along the Snow Road bridge overpass between Engle Road and Route 237, in front of the Ford Motor Company, Cleveland Engine Plant; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: That this Council does hereby designate the month of October, 2016 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month in Brook Park and will show our support in lighting up our pavilion with pink lights.

SECTION 2: We encourage our residents to join us in the witnessing of the Bras Across The Bridge Exhibit in Brook Park on September 30, 2016, beginning in the morning and ending in the evening, to show our support of Breast Cancer Awareness.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its

committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City and to show support provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
