RESOLUTION NO. 34-2019

INTRODUCED BY: COUNCILMAN POINDEXTER

A RESOLUTION
SUPPORTING THE STRIKING GENERAL MOTORS UNITED AUTO WORKERS,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, strikes are a tactic of last resort when bargaining for dignity and basic needs has failed; and

WHEREAS, approximately 50,000 United Auto Workers members nationwide and the UAW local 1005 in Parma went on strike September 16, 2019 against General Motors for the following issues:

- * Lack of investment in U.S. manufacturing
- * Closure of U.S. plants
- * Job Security
- * Abuse and mistreatment of temporary workers
- * Healthcare

WHEREAS, General Motors' profits were over \$2 billion in 2018, and Mary Barra, the CEO of General Motors made over \$22 million in salary and compensation in 2018; and

WHEREAS, UAW members want better pay and working conditions after years of sacrifices and divisive two-tier benefit schemes and management responded by threatening to cancel the health insurance for all striking workers; and

WHEREAS, General Motors is losing \$90 million a day, and thousands of auto workers are draining their savings, with no end in sight; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: This Council does hereby declare its support for the UAW members and urge Mary Barra, the CEO of General Motors

along with General Motors to come to a fair agreement with the workers who make their company successful.

SECTION 2: The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to Mary Barra, CEO of General Motors and to the UAW local 1005 Parma.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for further reason to show support to the UAW and their members; therefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
