A RESOLUTION  
URGING THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
TO NAME THE SNOW ROAD BRIDGE OVERPASS  
THE 'VETERANS MEMORIAL BRIDGE'  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 5533 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for the naming of a highway, road or bridge in memory of an individual or individuals; and

**WHEREAS**, the American Legion Post 610 acknowledges sponsorship of the City of Brook Park's 'Veterans Memorial Bridge' Project in naming this overpass; and

**WHEREAS**, the American Legion Post 610 will purchase all flags and materials representing the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines and Coast Guard for a total of 30 flags (15) on each side of the bridge; and

**WHEREAS**, signs will be installed by the Service Department and posted at each entrance of the bridge acknowledging sponsorship by the American Legion Post 610 and the City of Brook Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Brook Park along with the Mayor would like to honor veterans by naming the Snow Road bridge overpass between Engle Road and Route 237, in front of the Ford Motor Company, Cleveland Engine Plant 'Veterans Memorial Bridge'; and

**WHEREAS**, there will be a dedication ceremony on Friday, November 11, 2016 at 12:00 p.m.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

**SECTION 1:** The Mayor and Council of the City of Brook Park hereby support the naming the Snow Road bridge overpass the 'Veterans Memorial Bridge'

hereby support the naming the Snow Road bridge overpass the "Veterans Memorial Bridge."

**SECTION 2:** The American Legion Post will purchase all the flags and materials at a one-time cost of \$1,050.00 and the City of Brook Park will maintain the project.

**SECTION 3:** The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and instructed to forward certified copies of this Resolution to the Legislative Affairs Coordinator, Ohio Department of Transportation, 1980 West Broad Street, Columbus, OH 43223, the American Legion Post 610, at 19944 Sheldon Road, Brook Park, OH 44142.

**SECTION 4:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 5:** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason to urge the Ohio Department of Transportation to name the Snow Road bridge overpass the "Veterans Memorial Bridge"; provided that this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least five (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
