A RESOLUTION
URGING THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION
TO HAVE A COMMUNITY MEETING WITH THE
CITY OF BROOK PARK IN REFERENCE TO THE
FLIGHTS PATHS AT CLEVELAND HOPKINS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") is seeking public comment on routes that airplanes should fly in and out of Cleveland Hopkins International Airport; and

WHEREAS, the FAA is preparing to convert the airspace around Cleveland Hopkins International Airport to satellite-based navigation from ground-based navigation; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: That the Council of the City of Brook Park, hereby requests the FAA to meet with the City of Brook Park so that we may have our own community meeting and input before it draws new flight paths for Cleveland Hopkins International Airport.

SECTION 2: The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to Barry Cooper, Great Lakes Regional Administrator, Federal Aviation Administration, O'Hare Lake Office Center, 2300 East Devon Avenue, Des Plaines, IL 60018 and to Fred Szabo, Interim Director of Port Control, 5300 Riverside Drive, Cleveland, OH 44135.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further that the City of Brook Park requests the FAA to meet with the City regarding change in flight patterns; therefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of at least (5) members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
