A RESOLUTION
AFFIRMING THE CITY'S INTEREST IN PARTICIPATING
IN THE ESTABLISHMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A
REGIONAL DISPATCH CENTER IN COOPERATION WITH THE
CITY OF OLMSTED FALLS AND OLMSTED TOWNSHIP AT THE
SOUTHWEST GENERAL HEALTH CENTER,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park, the City of Olmsted Falls, and Olmsted Township are coordinating efforts to establish a Regional Dispatch Center to be located at the Southwest General Health Center; and

WHEREAS, the City is reviewing matters related to establishing the Southwest Dispatch Regional Council of Governments; and

WHEREAS, the City of Olmsted Falls has received a \$900,000 FEMA Grant to help facilitate establishment of a regional dispatch center and said grant will soon expire if not used for the grant time period extended by FEMA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: The City of Brook Park hereby affirms its interest in participating in the establishment and implementation of a Regional Dispatch Center.

SECTION 2: That the City of Brook Park shall continue to review the matters and issues related establishing the Southwest Dispatch Regional Council of Governments.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings

open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and immediately express the City of Brook Park's affirmation of its interest in establishing a Regional Dispatch Center; therefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
