A RESOLUTION
URGING OHIO VOTERS TO SUPPORT STATE ISSUE I,
RENEWAL OF THE STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM
ON MAY 6, 2014,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ohio local communities are in continuing need of support for vital road, bridge, sewer, water and other infrastructure projects; and

WHEREAS, Ohio has in place a state program of support for local communities which not only helps to fund infrastructure projects, but also creates large numbers of construction and allied jobs; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio State Capital Improvements Program has successfully provided support for more than 11,500 projects and resulting job creation since its inception in 1987; and

WHEREAS, Issue 1 on the May 6, 2014 statewide ballot provides Ohio voters with the opportunity to renew the program by authorizing issuance of \$1,875 billion in capital improvement bonds; and

WHEREAS, no new taxes are required to fund repayment of the bonds;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and Council of the City of Brook Park hereby declares its support for State Issue 1, and urges Ohio voters to cast their votes in support of continuing the infrastructure improvement and job creation Issue 1 will foster.

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public

in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason that the City of Brook Park urges Ohio voters to show their support for State Issue 1; therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
