A RESOLUTION  
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION WITH THE  
CUYAHOGA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT FOR A  
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds are now available through the Cuyahoga County Department of Development, and the City desires to make application for such funding for an infrastructure improvements including concrete joint repairs, concrete slab replacements, concrete curb repairs, curb inlet repairs/replacements, curb inlet installations, minor storm sewer work, and ADA curb ramp upgrades on Michael Drive between Snow Road and Hummel Road.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: That the Council of the City of Brook Park, hereby authorizes the Mayor to seek an application for a Community Development Block Grant of \$150,000 for infrastructure improvements on Michael Drive between Snow Road and Hummel Road.

SECTION 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of said City, and for further reason to authorize the Mayor to file an application

with the Cuyahoga County Department of Development for a block grant; therefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
