A RESOLUTION
HONORING AYDEN WEDDLE
ON CALLING EMS FOR HELP IN A MEDICAL EMERGENCY
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ayden Weddle is seven years old and dialed 911 for EMS when his father suffered a diabetic seizure; and

WHEREAS, Ayden Weddle did not panic while his father was unresponsive and kept his two year old brother calm; and

WHEREAS, Ayden Weddle was able to direct the police officers into his house and further provide them with a list of emergency contacts;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio that:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Council wish to honor seven year old Ayden Weddle in saving his father from further complications and possible injuries.

SECTION 2: The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to Ayden Weddle and his parents.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of said city, and for further reason to honor Ayden Weddle; therefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
