AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO
AN AGREEMENT WITH COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS
FOR GRANT FUNDING FOR REIMBURSEMENT COSTS OF MATERIALS
USED IN PERFORMING MAINTENANCE OF COUNTY ROUTES,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County has grant funding available through the Department of Public Works for reimbursement costs of materials used in performing maintenance of county routes

WHEREAS, the City of Brook Park would like to participate in this program in order to be able to apply for grant funding for reimbursement costs of materials used in maintenance of county routes; and

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial to the City to participate in this program for roadway maintenance; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Brook Park, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The Council for the City of Brook Park hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into an Agreement with the Cuyahoga County Public Works Department.

SECTION 2: The money needed for the aforesaid transaction shall be paid from funds theretofore appropriated or to be appropriated for said purpose.

SECTION 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of said City, and for the further reason for the City of Brook Park to enter into a contract with the Cuyahoga County for road maintenance of county roads; therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
